Host Ranch-Beldon Bison Ranch Requirements and Parameters

- **All bulls must be previously entered and accepted into the SBA CBBB**
- **Management & Service Fee:** \$1,350.00(includes pasture, grower pellets, vaccination, deworming, all semen testing, handling, weighing, and health and nutrition management.
Due upon delivery of bull(s) to host ranch
- **Bull Delivery:** April 2017 with prior arrangements with host ranch.
- **Weigh in Dates:** Tentatively 1, Oct, Dec, Prior to end of February with two committee members present.
- **Treatment at initial weighing:** Bulls will receive Ivermectin, 8-way, and anthrax vaccine.
- **Draft program bull management:**
 1. Test bulls kept in a separate pen for about two weeks and fed to allow for familiarization.
 2. With host ranch bulls they will be put out to pasture for about 60 days with access to supplemental grain or pellets
 3. Bull will then be turned out to pasture with access to supplemental grain or pellets. Mid fall 2016 bulls will be brought in from pasture.
 4. The bulls will be weighed (two committee members present) and they will be placed into a group which may include host farm replacement bulls and will continue on supplemental grain or pellets plus hay.
 5. Bulls will remain on this feed regimen until the end of the Draft program
 6. Final weighing will take place prior to the end of February 2018 (two committee members will be present).
Consignors whose bulls have unfavorable weights and or gains will be contacted by a committee member prior to the release of the results of that specific weigh in. Consignors will be given the opportunity to remove their bull(s) from the Draft program but not the host ranch. **Consignors of bulls that:** A) are removed from the CBBB program B) do not make the top ??? ranked CBBB bulls B) do not pass the semen testing: will be offered a fair market price for said bull by the host ranch. If the consignor does not wish to accept this the host ranch will at their discretion arrange a date and time for the consignor to pick up their bulls.

Liabilities:

Beldon Bison Ranch - Host ranch will not be responsible for any losses to consignor animals. The consignors will retain ownership of their bison and as such assumes all responsibilities in regard to the terms and conditions of this futurity. Consignors are welcome to independently purchase insurance for their bulls at their own expense.
The Saskatchewan Bison Association and the Beldon Bison Ranch - host ranch act only as facilitators of the CBBB and will assume NO responsibility in the event of injury or death or of a discrepancy.
Furthermore CBBB Consignors will not be liable for the loss of any host ranch animals comingled with the futurity animals. Delivery of bulls to Beldon Bison Ranch implies full agreement to the terms set out in this agreement.
